CUTA's mission is defined by law: to ensure as far as possible the safety of the Belgian citizens and the interests of Belgium within the Belgian borders as well as abroad with respect the principles of the democratic rule of law.





The events of the past couple of years have led the security services to rethink and better coordinate their approach to combating terrorism and extremism. A good security policy requires intensive cooperation and mutual trust. The exchange and sharing of information and data is a prerequisite, which is why the "C" in our name plays such an important role. The challenge now is to continue on the course we have embarked on. As a centre of expertise and knowledge, we want to support civil society and the different levels of authority in further developing a holistic, integrated and common approach to the prevention of violent extremism.
